Examination Results 2023

Headline figures for 2023:

- 135 students sat 1,241 GCSE Examinations (or an equivalent vocational qualification).
- 83% of our students achieved a Grade 4 or higher in both English and Mathematics.
- 62% of our students achieved a Grade 5 or higher in both English and Mathematics.
- 33% of our students' results were Grade 7 or higher (vocational Grade D2 or above).

To achieve a pass in a Level 2 examination, students need to attain a GCSE Grade 4 (or above), or P2 (or above) in a vocational qualification.
